ABOUT GRACE HILL CHURCH

After much prayer and fasting, Elder Beryl I. Cowthran shared a vision with seven people of like mind. They met often to pray and plan and would decide to organize Grace Hill Church, "The Place Where God Heals." On Thursday, August 10, 2017, the church was incorporated. Grace Hill held its first official worship service at 1211 Airport Drive, Shreveport, Louisiana on Sunday, October 8, 2017. The membership immediately grew from seven to over twenty members. During this time, the vision was expanded and expounded upon. The Vision, Mission, and Grace Expectations were shared by Pastor Cowthran and founding member, Omosefe Amen, was inspired to pray and share the Grace Agreements.

The Church remained at 1211 Airport Drive (Shreveport, Louisiana) until June 2018. In June, the church moved to 1303 Line Avenue where it continues to flourish. March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared the COVID1-19 pandemic. Immediately, Grace Hill Church pivoted to online worship. The ministry remained in cadence with the voice of God. Founding member Minister Tariq Hill continued astutely managing the business matters of the ministry while Pastor Cowthran continued attending to the spiritual needs of the membership while navigating within the space of a new virtual reality. During this time, the ministry leaders remained innovative in creating and imagining what the new virtual church needed to look like. Several members started returning to the sanctuary Resurrection Sunday, April 4, 2021.

We continue to disciple the Church to impact the world with the gospel of Jesus Christ. We endeavor to teach others that Jesus is the light of the world; thereby, encouraging them to transform from visionless lives to living purpose-filled according to God's divine plan. We hope to be examples of Christ in deed while personifying His loving character through grace.

SERVING WITH GRACE

What a blessing Grace Hill family has been to our local community. In 2024, we supported students at Wiley University with clothing, gift cards, and a financial contribution. With the collaborative efforts of our friends at Fab Finds Boutique, we have continuously donated clothing to the Cavalier Student Center at Bossier Parish Community College. Our outreach efforts have led us to serving and/or supplying the Hub Ministry, Hope Connections, Christian Services, and various nursing homes in our area. Students in Caddo Magnet High School's Black Study Program traveled to the nation's capitol and members of Grace Hill supported a high school student to attend the tour. Spring Semester 2024. Students were also permitted to use the building for practice in preparation for their debut African American History Program. With Tiffany Epps, our 2024 Missions Director, leading the way, we were introduced to Faith & Fostering and Five Loaves and Two Fish.

- Perpetuity- Both your family and the Grace Hill Family deserve to live without financial struggle. Create generational wealth and continue to give to others. Proverbs 13:22


